Available Opportunities:

- **Item Review Meetings:** Participants will review potential test questions for issues related to content, bias, and sensitivity that may affect the performance of particular groups of students.
- **Data Review Meetings:** Participants will review the performance data related to field test questions.
- **Range Finding:** Participants will score student responses using rubrics, and select sample responses for use in training.
